The following key statements have been defined by the company, as suitable measures in the detection and prevention of recruitment fraud.

- Oceanscan will never ask candidates for money, this includes money transfers, in return for any services
 or advice, at any point during the recruitment process. Candidates are responsible for paying any fees
 incurred in obtaining documents such as a medical certificate, discharge book, passport etc. Visa costs
 will be borne by the Client
- Oceanscan will never put a candidates CV forward for a job, nor disclose a candidate's personal information to any third-party without first obtaining their written permission to do so.
- Oceanscan does not use Social Media or Networking websites to act as a tool in order to 'poach' individuals' information and act as an agency in order to extract money from them.
- Oceanscan will never disclose client information to any third-party without prior written consent.
- Check the email address and any web addresses our emails all end with @oceanscan.co.uk. A
 fraudulent address could be something similar, but it cannot be the same.
- You will always be able to use a landline phone number, not just a mobile. If you have the name of someone you will be able to contact them via the switchboard phone numbers available on our website.
- The Oceanscan logo and name are on the website ensure documents and communications have the same look. Any differences are likely to be fraudulent
- All personal information is kept strictly private and confidential.
- Details of any recent incidents of fraud concerning Oceanscan or the Oceanscan logo are detailed on the company website at www.oceanscan.co.uk.
